We'll walk about 1/2 mile to just past the railroad bridge. You can return to the parking
lot at any time or rest at a bench if you'd like. Wildflower walks are gentle with lots of
stops to see flowers and whatever else crops up.

Gather at the trail entrance from the parking lot, near the playground.

I love 'em but please don't bring Fido - leashes & people get tangled.
